



REQUEST FOR ADJUNCT STATUS – HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS

The Ohio College Credit Plus (CCP) Program, offered through The University of Akron, enables qualified high school students to earn college and high school graduation credit simultaneous through the successful completion of college courses. Courses offered through CCP are typically Ohio Transfer Module (OTM) or Transfer Assurance Guide (TAG) courses.

It is our intent to work collaboratively with our CCP high school partners to identify qualified high school teachers who may be able to serve as adjunct instructors. We welcome the opportunity to review and discuss specific qualifications with individual teachers and/or administrators. The University of Akron complies with the accrediting standards of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools Higher Learning Commission (HLC). Minimum instructor qualifications include:

- Master's degree in the content area OR
- Master's Degree PLUS 18 "approved" graduate credits in the content area

Credentials of potential instructors will be evaluated by the Department Chair of the specific content area. Approved instructors are expected to meet University expectations for performance and must participate in all required assessments and evaluations deemed necessary.

Interested high school faculty members must submit the following:

Completed Request for Adjunct Status form
Current resume/vitae
All undergraduate and graduate college transcripts
Any additional information that may be relevant
Indicate interest in teaching through UA Main Campus and/or UA Wayne College
List of UA courses you are interested in teaching
