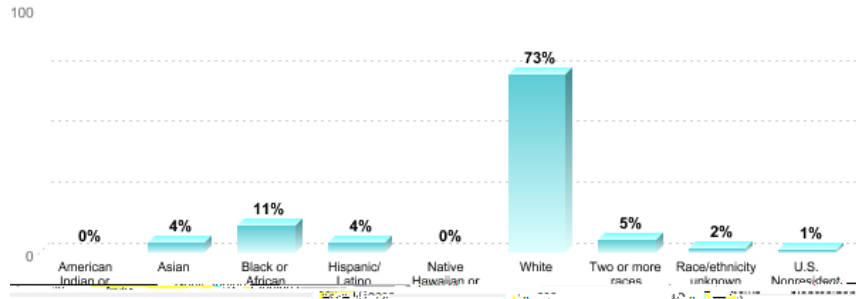

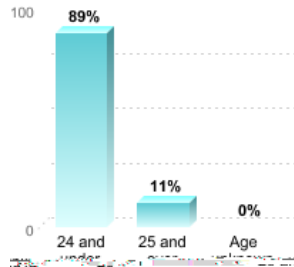

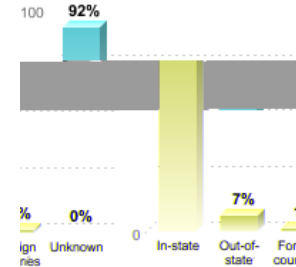
UNDERGRADUATE RACE/ETHNICITY



UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT AGE

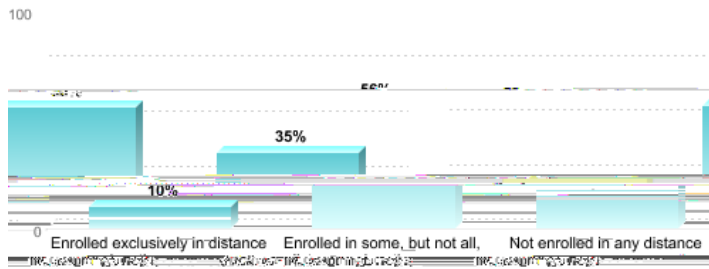


UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT RESIDENCE

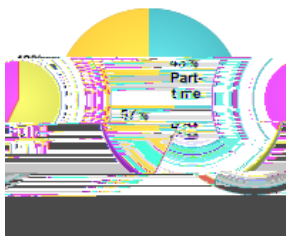

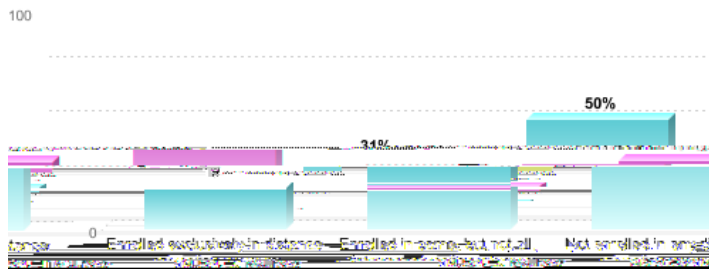
UNDERGRADUATE DISTANCE EDUCATION STATUS
