




Producing a What-If Report

6. Click on the	The Create What-If Scenario page appears

If additional plans are to be evaluated in the same scenario, insert a row under the Plan What-If Data row. Note: We do not utilize Sub-plans.</p>	
7. Click the  button.	<p data-bbox="789 1444 1386 1482">populate into the Program What-If Data fields.</p> <p data-bbox="789 1530 1403 1640">This is a time saving feature and is helpful in ensuring the correct Career and Program requirement terms are entered.</p>
8. If multiple rows were populated, click the delete row  button under the Program What-If Data bar to delete any unnecessary rows.	<p data-bbox="789 1650 1195 1688">Unnecessary rows are removed.</p>
