Adult Focus Advising Appointment includes:

  - i Determine last date of attendance
  - i Complete Undergraduate Enrollment form
  - i Review any previous coursework and academic options
  - i Discuss career objectives / major (Do I need to visit the Career Center, Student Union 212.4(Schrank Hall North 152. Website is [www.uakron.edu/testing](http://www.uakron.edu/testing))

- i Make another advising appointment with Adult Focus to:
    - o Discuss placement test scores and options
    - o Schedule classes for the next term
    - o Learn My Akron, Springboard (online learning platform)
  - i Visit Zip Card Office for Student ID Card (Bring a copy of your Class Schedule)
  - i Veteran Students: Meet with Military Services Center to apply for VA benefits and to learn about services (33027838 or [www.uakron.edu/veterans](http://www.uakron.edu/veterans))

## Financial

- i Determine financial standing
- i Student needs to complete FAFSA at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) (UA code: 003123)
- i Explain SAR Report
- i Explain Master Institutional Aid Application
- i Explain My Akron regarding Accepting or Declining Award
- i Check the status of your Financial Aid
- i Explain what to do when student receives aid (what happens next?)
- i Explain Refund Policy
- i Explain keeping your Aid
